So what? The “Old Testament” prophets, Moses and Isaiah are prophesying . . . “foretelling” the name of God.

The “New Testament” prophets, Matthew, Mark, Luke and John are prophesying as well, but they are “forth-telling” what has been “foretold.”

God has a name, “Ἐγὼ εἰμί κύριος יהוה LORD Yahweh.” This “proof” starts with the LXX, Septuagint, the Hebrew Scriptures translated into Greek at least 200 years before Jesus of Nazareth was conceived. Holy Spirit is “proving” from the Greek “Old Testament and the Greek New Testament” who Jesus of Nazareth was. Jesus desired His audience then to understand from their scriptures that Yahweh had become flesh (human) to save and therefore His name was Jesus . . . Yahweh is salvation . . . Strong’s word #H3091 (יהושע or יהושוע and #G2424 Ἰησοῦς) . . . Jehovah is salvation . . .

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Therefore they shall know in that day That I am He who speaks:
‘Behold, it is I.’”
