

The LORD is with you vs. Immanuel

Read the following scriptures first from a New King James Version and then from the American Standard Version. Same scriptures . . .

Gen 26:28 NKJV - But they said, "We have certainly seen that the **LORD (Yahweh) is with you**. So we said, 'Let there now be an oath between us, between you and us; and let us make a covenant with you,

Jdg 6:12 NKJV - And the Angel of the LORD appeared to him, and said to him, "The **LORD (Yahweh) is with you**, you mighty man of valor!"

2Sa 7:3 NKJV - Then Nathan said to the king, "Go, do all that is in your heart, for the **LORD (Yahweh) is with you**."

2Ch 15:2 NKJV - And he went out to meet Asa, and said to him: "Hear me, Asa, and all Judah and Benjamin. The **LORD (Yahweh) is with you** while you are with Him. If you seek Him, He will be found by you; but if you forsake Him, He will forsake you.

2Ch 20:17 NKJV - 'You will not need to fight in this battle. Position yourselves, stand still and see the **salvation of the LORD (Yahweh), who is with you**, O Judah and Jerusalem!' Do not fear or be dismayed; tomorrow go out against them, for the **LORD (Yahweh) is with you**."

Gen 26:28 ASV - And they said, We saw plainly that **Jehovah was with thee**. And we said, Let there now be an oath betwixt us, even betwixt us and thee, and let us make a covenant with thee,

Jdg 6:12 ASV - And the angel of Jehovah appeared unto him, and said unto him, **Jehovah is with thee**, thou mighty man of valor.

2Sa 7:3 ASV - And Nathan said to the king, Go, do all that is in thy heart; for **Jehovah is with thee**.

2Ch 15:2 ASV - and he went out to meet Asa, and said unto him, Hear ye me, Asa, and all Judah and Benjamin: **Jehovah is with you**, while ye are

with him; and if ye seek him, he will be found of you; but if ye forsake him, he will forsake you.

2Ch 20:17 ASV - Ye shall not need to fight in this [battle]: set yourselves, stand ye still, and see the salvation of Jehovah with you, O Judah and Jerusalem; fear not, nor be dismayed: tomorrow go out against them: for **Jehovah is with you.**

Isa 7:14 NKJV - "Therefore the Lord Himself will give you a sign: Behold, the virgin shall conceive and bear a Son, and shall call His name **Immanuel.**

Isa 7:14 ASV - Therefore the Lord himself will give you a sign: behold, a virgin shall conceive, and bear a son, and shall call his name **Immanuel.**

Isa 8:8 NKJV - He will pass through Judah, He will overflow and pass over, He will reach up to the neck; And the stretching out of his wings Will fill the breadth of Your land, **O Immanuel.**

Mat 1:23 NKJV - "Behold, the virgin shall be with child, and bear a Son, and they shall call His name **Immanuel,**" which is translated, "**God with us.**"

Luk 1:28 NKJV - And having come in, the angel said to her, "Rejoice, highly favored one, the **Lord (Jehovah or Yahweh) is with you;** blessed are you among women!"

Luk 1:28 ASV - And he came in unto her, and said, Hail, thou that art highly favored, the **Lord (Yahweh or Jehovah) [is] with thee.**

See the pattern . . . God "fore-tells" through the writers (prophets) of the "Old Testament" and "forth-tells" through the writers (prophets) of the "New Testament."

Do you see why Paul says the church is built on the foundation of Apostles and Prophets?

Again, don't get lost in the debate about whether it is Jehovah or Yahweh because we can all agree, by now, that God's name is not LORD, Lord or lord. Can't we?

So . . . If Yahweh is with us . . .and God with us . . . who is with us?

Yahweh was prophesying that He would become flesh . . . and dwell (tabernacle) with His people. . .

Jesus . . . Yeshua . . . Yehoshua . . . Yahweh is salvation . . . Messiah!!!!
